

Verification of Non-filing Statement for Tax Year 2022

Your FAFSA application was randomly selected by the federal processor for a process called "verification." The law states that before awarding Federal Student Aid we may ask you to confirm the information you (and for Dependent students, your parents) reported on your FAFSA. The Financial Aid Office will compare information from your FAFSA with your submitted financial documents. Bellevue College may be required to correct your FAFSA if there are differences between your FAFSA and the documents you submit for verification.

Required Steps:

- 1. Complete all sections of this form, including signature, in blue or black ink. (We cannot accept pencil.)
- 2. Submit this form and other required documents to the Financial Aid Office in person, or by mail or fax. Incomplete forms will not be accepted. These documents are required to complete your financial aid file and must be submitted prior to the quarterly deadline in order to be processed before the start of the quarter.
- 3. If you are filling out this form as the parent of a Bellevue College student, please include their ctcLink ID number in the space provided below.
