1. Start with one of the following at **Placement and Testing Services, U115:**

- Placement using **Guided Self-Placement Exam**
- Domestic high school transcript, with an overall GPA of 2.5 if graduation earned within last two years or 3.0 or higher if graduation earned over two years and within five years ago or high school coursework in-progress
- Appropriate scores on AP or IB exams
- Smarter Balanced Language Arts Level 3 or 4 score may be used in the year following HS graduation or for Running Start students
- Placement from another Washington State Community or Technical college (reciprocity), less than two years old
