



FEDERAL TAX INFORMATION DISCLOSURE CONSENT FORM - FTI

When completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) form to apply for financial aid, the applicant and any contributors consent to transfer their federal tax information (FTI) directly from the Internal Revenue Service (IRS). The Bellevue College Financial Aid Office receives this information and the FTI is used to determine and award financial aid. The Financial Aid Office may not redisclose the FTI transferred from the IRS to an aid applicant's FAFSA® form (including to other college departments) without separate, written consent from the aid applicant. Additionally, FTI data cannot be discussed with any other individuals without the explicit written consent of the aid applicant. If requested by the applicant, this form may be used to grant permission for the institution to release FTI for specific, approved purposes on a case-by-case basis.
