Purpose of the proposal and its anticipated effects, including any changes in existing rules: Bellevue College plans to update Library Media Center policy 3550 and WAC 132H-136 to remove holds on transcripts due to debt.

Reasons supporting proposal: Bellevue College proposes updates to the current Library Media Center (LMC) policy 3550 regarding fines. Changes are proposed to comply with Second Substitute House Bill (SSHB) 2513 (this bill prohibits colleges from withholding a student's official transcript for debt collection), to remove and/or update outdated information, and to clarify rules.
