#### Part I: General Education Requirements for Associate Degrees

Bellevue Community College offers seven associate degrees. Students must follow the appropriate degree guides listed below in order to fulfill all BCC graduation requirements.

<u>Transferability</u>. Three BCC associate degrees are generally transferable to participating 4-year universities: (1) Arts and Sciences –Direct Transfer (AAS-DTA); (2) Business (AB–DTA); and (3) Science (AS-Track I and AS-Track II). The Associate in Applied Sciences-Technical (AAS-T) is transferable to a limited number of universities through special agreement between BCC and the 4-year program. The Associate in Arts degree (AA) is not generally transferable; Associates in Arts in General Studies (AAGS) and Essential Studies (AES) are not transferable.

<u>General Education (GenEd) Requirements</u>. Each of BCC's associate degrees contains specific BCC general education requirements that are listed on the below URLs for each degree.
