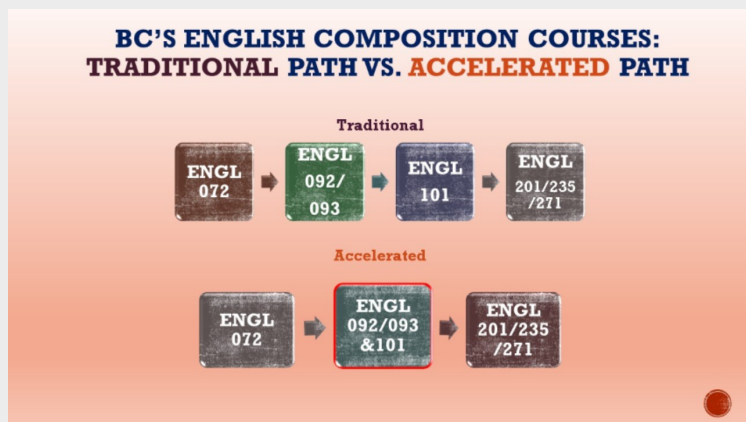


ACCELERATED COMPOSITION COURSES AT BELLEVUE COLLEGE



WHAT ARE ACCELERATED COMPOSITION COURSES?

Students in accelerated courses take their precollege course concurrently with English 101:



Students with English 092 or 093 placement may enroll in an accelerated sequence of two five-credit classes so they can complete the 092/093 and English 101 in the same quarter. One hour is a regular English 101 class, and the 092/093 is a smaller support class to work more closely with the English 101 assignments while getting extra time and practice with the 101 instructor and classmates.

The 092/093 section in a combination course consists of 10 students who will:

- Get clarification on 101 assignments, discussions, readings
- Deepen understanding of 101 readings through additional readings, vocabulary activities and assignments
- Brainstorm topics for 101 papers
- Receive and provide extra peer critique for 101 papers
- Check progress in both the 092/093 and 101 class

FAQs

Is the English 101 class easier because of the accelerated students?

English 101 is conducted like a regular 101 class. We maintain the same standards and academic rigor, as we would in any 101 section.

What should students expect once enrolled?

Instructors have high expectations and high support for both classes. Students will manage their time, workload and attendance; collaborate with other students; and practice motivation and focus techniques.

Will students succeed in accelerated composition courses?

Generally speaking, yes. Current data has shown that students are more successful in accelerated rather than taking the courses separately. Instructors and peers provide additional support throughout the quarter.

How to Enroll

Accelerated Courses are available in the fall, winter and spring quarters. Students must have placement into English 092/093.
