Spring 2018 AMATYC Student Mathematics League Moderator Directions for Reporting College Results

1. Print out the key for the test and grade all the tests. In the "Local Corrector" column mark a "C" for a correct answer, "X" for an incorrect answer, and a "B" for a question left blank.

Question #18 was one in which students were to write in the correct answer. If a student answers it correctly, it is scored as C. If he or she answers it incorrectly OR leaves it blank, it is to be scored as B (no papers should have this question marked as incorrect!)

Fill in the spaces on the answer sheet for # correct, # incorrect, and # blank and then calculate the score. Check your arithmetic - any mistakes caught now will save time later.

- 2. Any student who has not yet earned a two-year college or higher degree is eligible to be included in your team score and to be awarded individual prizes. Be sure each of your top five scorers has answered the question on the answer sheet regarding this requirement if not, verify that they do not have a degree, then circle the correct answer to the question yourself and initial your circle.
- 3. Go to the SML Scoreboard http://sml.matyc.org to enter your scores. Your password is the same as it was in the last round. If you do not remember your password, select your college from the pull-down list and then click on the word "here" in the second paragraph of the directions. A password will then be sent to you at the e-mail address you entered when you registered for the Student Math League. If you do not get a response within an hour, check your spam filter and then email susanst@csmd.edu for your password. If your school has had a moderator change, email susanst@csmd.edu to have your password sent to you.

Once you receive the password, return to the Scoreboard, select your college and enter your password. You will now be taken to the data input page for your college. You need to input the scores for your college's top five Round 2 students. Input each name, gender and Round 2 score. If your college had less than five students participate, include all of your students. The webpage will automatically compute your team score.

If you would like to input the scores of additional students, feel free to do so, as long as they have not received a two-year or higher degree and you submit their paper to me. When deciding how many additional students to add, I would recommend that you not submit any more than ten. I encourage you to keep your own spreadsheet of all scores on the SML from your school. In that way, we can get an accurate count at the end of both rounds as to how many students participated during the year.

Please do **NOT** enter student's names in all capital letters on the Scoreboard.

- 4. Fill out the Spring 2018 Summary Sheet. Your signature at the bottom of the sheet verifies that you followed the Student Mathematics League policies while administering the test.
- 5. Mail the Summary Sheet and the **original** answer sheets for all students you entered on the web page (there must be a one-to-one correspondence between the student's names on the Scoreboard and the answer sheets mailed to me) to


