#### HOW TO PREPARE FOR YOUR ACADEMIC ADVISING APPOINTMENT

- Make the appointment a priority. If you schedule an appointment please do all you can to keep it. If you can't
  keep the appointment, we understand, but please do your best to call and cancel so someone else can have that
  spot.
  - o **REMINDER**: advising appointments can be scheduled in advance, or same-day; appointments can occur in-person or over the phone.
- Come prepared to ask questions and be prepared to answer some questions your advisor may ask. It's all to get to know you better and more clearly understand your goals, aspirations, and needs.
- Come prepared to do some work. This is a partnership between you <u>and</u> your advisor. You will both play an active role during this appointment.
- Come prepared with necessary materials. If you have **transcript**s you need reviewed, please print and bring them with you. If you have a form that needs a signature, please bring it.
- This time is important for your future. Please limit distractions during the appointment so you can make the most of the time with your advisor.

#### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING AN ACADEMIC ADVISING APPOINTMENT

Lots of questions! During your appointment you may be asked...

- Questions regarding your program of study. Are you...
  - Completing an Associate's Degree or a Certificate?
  - o Do you plan to transfer to a university? If so, do you have any schools in mind?
  - o Do you have a major in mind?
- Questions about your goals (education and career).
- If you are planning for full-time or part-time enrollment.
- Did you complete foreign language in high school?
- If you have other things going on outside of school that should be considered when planning classes (i.e. work, family, commuting, etc.).
- If there are additional things we need to be aware of as we create an education plan (i.e. Running Start student, financial aid recipient, non-WA state resident, international student, Veteran, etc.)
- How the quarter is going. What's going well? Are there any challenges you're facing?
- If we notice (or you share) that you're having a rough time we may ask additional questions about campus resources you're using, on and off campus support systems you have in place to help you, etc.
- Academic Advisors do MORE than course planning! We work to support your educational and personal success at BC and beyond!
