The energy bill for March was \$133,982; meaning BC spends more than \$4,000 on energy costs every day, and over \$1.4 million on energy costs every year. Energy Check is an event designed to lower those numbers, save BC money, and help BC become more sustainable! Look for Energy Check student around campus June 1st and 2nd. This program is being piloted with the Captains of Sustainability.
