

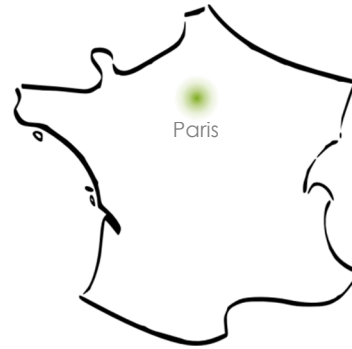
## ➔ Who is eligible?

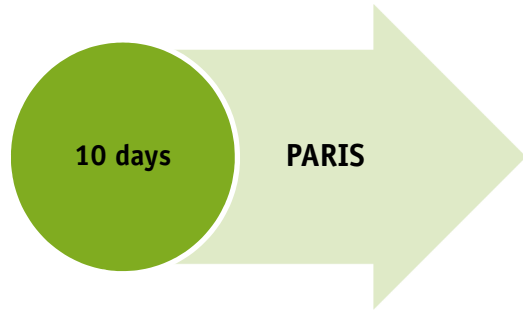
