#### Solar Plus Storage Grant

Bellevue College has been awarded \$100,000 in funding from the Washington State Department of Commerce to plan for a solar array tied to energy storage on our campus! This project will begin with a feasibility study in July 2024, and will be aimed at increasing community resilience, by providing an emergency shelter and emergency operations center on campus in the event of a natural disaster.

### Fall Cleaning

Clean out or replace your furnace filter regularly and get your furnace serviced by a professional before the cold weather calls.
