

APA 7 Style Citations

Citation Formatting Basics:

- All references cited in the text should be listed alphabetically by author's last name.
- Pay close attention to the punctuation and layout citations are picky!
- Capitalize only the first word of a title and subtitle, the first word after a colon, and proper nouns.
- The DOI is the digital object identifier and can typically be found in the database record or at the top of the journal article.

Authored book chapter	Jones, J. (2004). Harder times: The Great Depression. In L.K. Kerber & J.S. De Hart (Eds.), <i>Women's America:</i> *Refocusing the past (6 th ed., pp. 429-432). Oxford University Press.

Basic scholarly journal format	Author, A. A., & Author, B. B. (Date). Title of article. <i>Title of Journal, volume number</i> (issue number), page range. https://DOI or URL

Basic magazine format	Author, A. A. (Year, Month date). Title of article. <i>Title of Magazine, volume number</i> (issue number), page range.

Basic newspaper format	Author, A. A. (Year, Month date). Title of article. <i>Title of Newspaper</i> , page range.
Example	Baker, P., Thrush, G., & Haberman, M. (2017, September 30). Health Secretary resigns over chartered jet flights. <i>New York Times</i> , A1.
Basic website format	Last Name, First Initial. (Date of publication). Title of the webpage or site. URL

Website with organization as author	MedlinePlus. (2017, October 4). GERD: Also called: Gastroesophageal reflux disease. https://medlineplus.gov/gerd.html
