



TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Washington State Community and Technical Colleges and

The Evergreen State College

Statement of Purpose

This transfer agreement is to ensure that students who complete one of the degrees listed below at a public community or technical college in the State of Washington will have smooth transfer of course credits, enter Evergreen with junior-level standing, and be on a path to earn an Evergreen baccalaureate degree in a timely fashion.

Transfer Agreement

Pursuant to state statute, a student who has earned a transferable associate of arts or sciences, or an associate of science transfer degree, when admitted to a four-year institution of higher education shall have junior standing.

Above and beyond the statute, The Evergreen State College will guarantee transfer-in of 90 credits that are degree applicable, thereby each student is not only a junior, but will be 90 credits away from graduating.

In addition, graduates from any State of Washington community or technical college with one of the following applied or vocational technical degrees may qualify for Evergreen's **Upside Down Transfer Option** and transfer in 90 degree-applicable credits:

- Associate of Applied Science (AAS)
- Associate of Applied Science-Transfer (AAS-T)
- Associate in Technical Arts (ATA)
- Associate in Applied Technology (AAT)

Conditions

- Earn one of the technical associate degrees listed above from a State of Washington community or technical college
- Complete ENGL 101 with a GPA of 2.0 (C) or higher

- Complete a minimum of 20 academic quarter hours of college-level credits with a GPA of 2.0
 (C) or higher in each course
 - No more than 10 credits earned in the same subject area can count toward the 20 credit minimum
- Have a cumulative college-level GPA of 2.5 or higher

Notification of Degree Changes

Colleges, through SBCTC, will immediately notify Evergreen of any proposed changes to its degrees listed in this agreement. Evergreen may adjust eligibility or conditions based on these changes.

Evergreen will immediately notify SBCTC, which will inform colleges, of any proposed changes to this MOU.

Additionally

Under the terms of this articulation agreement, community and technical colleges will advise students about baccalaureate opportunities at The Evergreen State College.

Community and technical colleges will include Evergreen baccalaureate promotional materials and information when providing similar information and materials about public and private baccalaureate options for students.

Evergreen will offer free transfer credit evaluations to any Washington state community or technical college student who wants confirmation of admission and transfer credit eligibility.

This articulation agreement may be cancelled by either party with one-year written notice.
