The library supports all students. Classes from every division use the D240L classroom.

Timeline for Expenditure(s): The current computers were installed in 2011 and are now obsolete. The all-in-one model of computer is no longer used on campus; there are no spare parts to fix the computers we have. Students note increasing frustration with the slowness of the computes, and some computers simply don't work properly.

The current computers have been in use for 6 years. An investment at this time would ensure proper computing power for at least 4 years. D240L is a heavily used computer classroom. In a given quarter, over 3000 students use the computer lab from a multitude of programs in every division.

Here is a sample of usage, from 2014-2015. I can provide additional statistics if required. The general trend is for increased usage, as student evaluations are now electronic and many instructors choose to use the D240L classroom to conduct student evaluations.

In the future, this area and the space outside of the classroom is envisioned as a learning commons area, where student can study, use computers and receive academic support all in one place. The utilization of the D240L classroom will likely change to fit this model and provide support to students.
