3. NEW BUSINESS

- i. STF Budget / Reserve Budget (Jarka)
 - Budget was reviewed and document will be sent to members after the meeting with the notes
 - Question from ASG President Alarick – What department do the salary’s cover both for the student and full-time employee?
 - Answered by Rodger – Student and Hourly employees are from the student IT workers in 3 lab locations, Full-time is a percent based on the work done
 - Follow-up question has the fee been increased
 - Answer was not that Rodger is aware of
 - Follow-up question on the current deficit of 107,097
 - Answer from Jarka that is based on the projection of the income vs expenses
 - Answer from Rodger the last two years has been negative for the income of the STF fee

- ii. STF Request
 - ID Card Funding Request
 - Alarick motions, Haesol second
 - Amy is in attendance to review the request for the ID funding request
 - Rodger asked if this is to pay for the entire ID Card system
 - Amy answers said that this sound cover all 3 phases
 - Rodger asked if it covers the supplies
 - Amy said it should cover the first 2 years of supplies
 - Camera, materials,
 - Jarka asked what percent the college would fund vs the college funding
 - Amy answers that it will cover a third of the cost
 - Jarka asked about the employees using the resource
 - Amy answers that the system will be set up for recharges to department for the employee cards
 - Venice asked about the purpose of the ID card and if it is for access
 - Amy answers that the card will be multi-functional for swipe card, school event,
 - Venice asked about what partnership will be made with communities
 - Amy answers said it will be discount at specific locations

 - Read & Write Software Request

 - Ali is in attendance to review the request for the ID funding request
 - Ali shared what the software does, anyone can access the software, has text to speech function, built in dictionary, dictation, academic tools. There isn't a good way to track the usage but seems like it is being used. This will be the third year of funding from the STF Fee.
 - Venice uses the software and does like the software
 - Alarick is wondering how many students this has benefited from this system
 - Ali said they don't have the data to say how much
