

Financial Aid Information for Workforce Education Students

To apply for all available aid, you must complete each step listed below. All required documents must be submitted as soon as possible for priority processing. Some types of financial aid are limited. Those students who complete all of their financial aid steps prior to the priority dates are most likely to receive their maximum eligible aid package.

- 1. Create your FSA ID at *https://fsaid.ed.gov/npas/index.htm* to sign and save your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) electronically. You only need to do this once.
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on the web at: www.fafsa.gov (or if eligible, complete the WASFA: Washington Application for Sate Financial Aid at: https://readysetgrad.wa.gov/wasfa-washington-application-state-financial-aid) and be sure to list BC using our school code of 003769. You will need your completed 2018 income tax return to complete the FAFSA/WASFA
- 3. You will receive a Student Aid Report (SAR) after your FAFSA/WASFA is processed. Review your SAR to determine if you must resolve any errors and/or provide any additional documents to our office such as citizenship, selective service and income verification.
- 4. Apply for the college admissions following the instruction sheet **PRIOR TO MEETING WITH YOUR** WORKFORCE EDUCATION ADVISOR.
- 5. Set up your Bellevue College Student E-mail at *https://www.bellevuecollege.edu/netid/ (*A Bellevue College issued email account is the primary way the Financial Aid office sends communications about your aid. Once you've received your Student Identification Number (SID),
- 6. Complete the BC Financial Aid Application at www.bellevuecollege.edu/fa/application
