# Do I Qualify for Workforce Education Grants?

## Workforce Education may be able to pay for tuition, fees, and potentially other school-related costs such as books and transportation, for eligible students in approved programs of study.

### You may qualify if <u>ANY</u> of the following statements describe you:

#### **Basic Food Employment & Training (BFET):**

□ I currently receive federal Basic Food assistance (SNAP/EBT). *Note: you can check eligibility at www.washingtonconnection.org* 

#### WorkFirst:

□ I am a parent currently receiving TANF (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families).

#### **Opportunity Grant:**

My monthly income is at or below the levels in the <u>table to the right</u> and I don't have a bachelor's degree. Note: you might need to include your parents' income if you are under 24 years old

#### Worker Retraining:

- □ I currently receive or have applied for unemployment benefits
- I am recently unemployed and plan to apply for unemployment benefits
- I have used up all my unemployment benefits in the past 4 years AND I am currently unemployed
- □ I am active duty military, but have separation orders
- □ I was discharged from the military within the past 4 years
- □ I was dependent on my spouse's income but am no longer supported by that income AND I have limited or no work experience/skills
- □ I am formerly self-employed and closed my full-time, successful business due to industry decline
