

Do I Qualify for Workforce Education Grants?

Workforce Education may be able to pay for tuition, fees, and potentially other school-related costs such as books and transportation, for eligible students in [approved programs of study](#).

You may qualify if ANY of the following statements describe you:

Basic Food Employment & Training (BFET):

- ☐ I currently receive federal Basic Food assistance (SNAP/EBT).
Note: you can check eligibility at www.washingtonconnection.org

WorkFirst:

- ☐ I am a parent currently receiving TANF (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families).

Opportunity Grant:

- ☐ My monthly income is at or below the levels in the [table to the right](#) and I don't have a bachelor's degree. *Note: you might need to include your parents' income if you are under 24 years old*

Worker Retraining:

- ☐ I currently receive or have applied for unemployment benefits
- ☐ I am recently unemployed and plan to apply for unemployment benefits
- ☐ I have used up all my unemployment benefits in the past 4 years AND I am currently unemployed
- ☐ I am active duty military, but have separation orders
- ☐ I was discharged from the military within the past 4 years
- ☐ I was dependent on my spouse's income but am no longer supported by that income AND I have limited or no work experience/skills
- ☐ I am formerly self-employed and closed my full-time, successful business due to industry decline
