


# Internal Connection

#### Point Of View



To present two or more opposing elements for better comparative understanding




#### Balance

Contrasting elements work together to create a state of equilibrium. One does not outweigh the other but co-exist in harmony.




#### Repetition

To experience a feeling, process, or action multiple times to create a sense of understanding















### Site Plan













Second Floor Plan - 1/8" Scale


Main Entrance - Lobby entrance view from parking lot.

**Check-In Counter -** Close up view of check in desk and surrouniding seating







Gift Shop - Open glass space for purchasing goods











Main Lobby- Lobby entrance from central courtyard, Check-in desk, and shopping area




**Back Lobby -** Waiting room between the changing rooms and massage rooms

**Yoga Studio** - Studio used for yoga and meditation classes, with access to side courtyard




Massage Room - Doubles massage room














## Ceiling Detail & Lighting
