


Early Alert Totals

- Total alerts: 356
- Alerts with unique SIDs: 310 (87%)
- Alerts with duplicate SIDs*: 47 (13%)

*students may have had more than one alert due to instructor error, multiple alerts for the same class, or alerts for multiple classes.




Alerts by Type

Alerts for Math and English*

Math	15% of all alerts were for Math	Of the math 53 alerts, 17 were for pre-college classes (32%).
English	7% of all alerts were for English	Of the 25 English alerts, 5 were for pre-college classes (20%).

General Admission Students	67.68%




Alerts for First Generation Students

No, not first generation	68%




Alerts by Race



- People with multiple who selected multiple identities were placed with the first ethnicity identified. For example, if someone indicated "African American; Asian" they were placed in "African American".
- Asian includes Pacific Islander students

- How many students are retained to the next quarter?
- How many students completed the course of concern?
 How many completed the course with a 2.0 or higher?
- How many students completed the quarter with a 2.0 GPA?
- Are different student populations represented equally in the Early Alert data?
- What is the distribution of adjunct and full-time faculty submitting alerts?
- Which courses have higher than average withdrawal rates?
- Determining impact by talking with students in focus groups
