



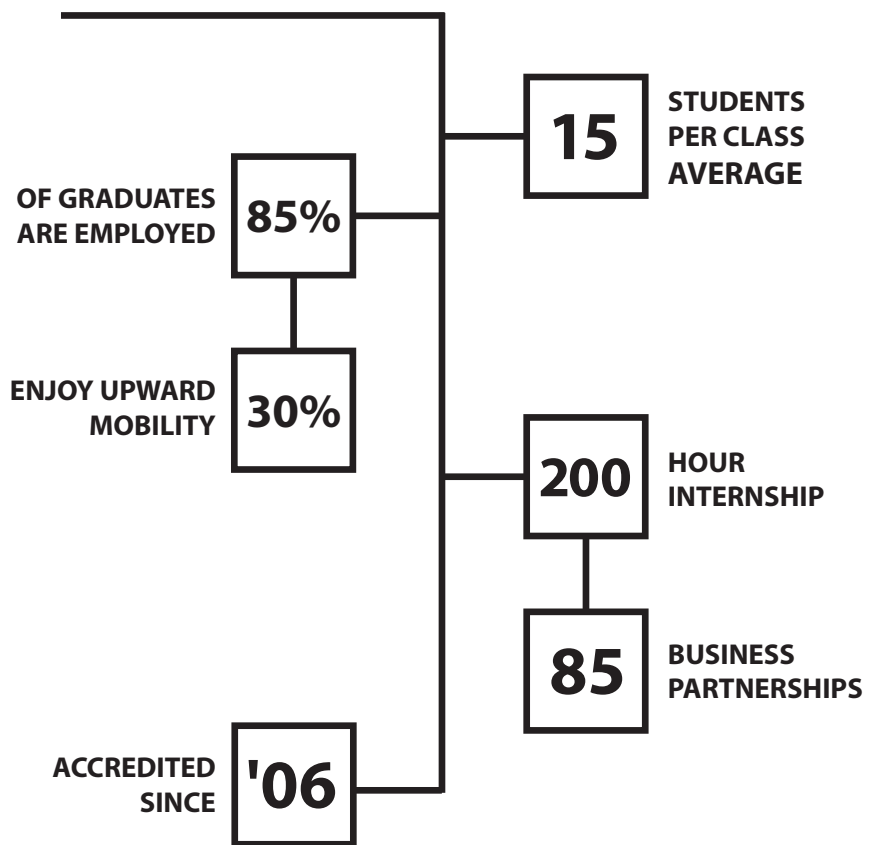
WHO WE ARE
