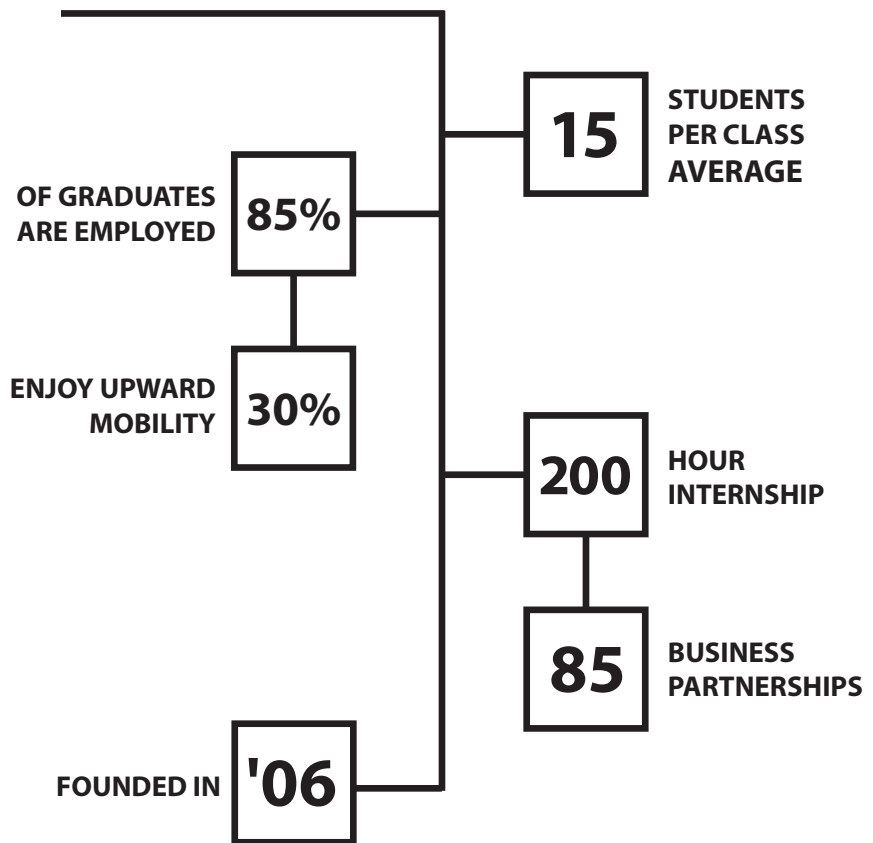
WHO WE ARE
