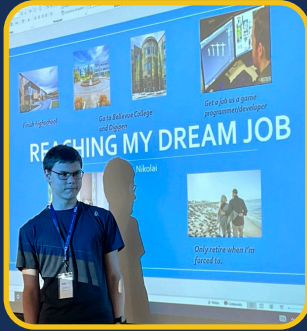


Occupational & Life Skills (OLS) Summer Camps
