- Self-healing cutting mat
- White artist's tape
- X-acto knife and scissors
- Metal ruler or right angle
- Bristol Drawing pad 18"x24"
- Drawing board for 18x24
- Graphite drawing pencils 2B and 6B, and white plastic eraser
- Small acrylic matte medium and UHU glue stick
- 2" foam paint applicator
- Cotton rags, plastic drop cloth, water container
- Brushes: #8 and 12 round, 1/4" and 3/4" flats (soft synthetic hair for acrylics and watercolors)
- Pallet: large white plastic flat (no little wells), or lg paper pallets
- Artist-grade paint: acrylics, or watercolor, or gouache. Colors:
 - White
 - Black
 - Paynes gray
 - Alizarin crimson
 - Cad red
 - Phthalo blue
 - Ultramarine blue
 - Cerulean blue
 - Hansa yellow light
 - Cadmium yellow or new gamboge
 - Burnt sienna
 - Raw sienna
 - Burnt umber
 - Raw umber
 - Violet or purple
- Vinyl gloves (optional)
- Apron (optional)

Bring this list to the art store, they can be very helpful and often times there may be a 10% discount at some stores if you are a BC student as well.
