#### You will need:

## • Watercolor Paper

140 lb., cold-press, 15 to 30 sheet pads at 9" x 12" or larger. The two following options are recommended:

- o Fabriano Studio Acquarello Watercolour Pad, 9" x 12"
- o Strathmore 400 Series Watercolor Pad, 9.5" x 12.5"

#### Palette and Paint

A small palette with 8 to 12 colors in it. The premade value or student sets are a good choice. Recommended:

- Windsor and Newton Cotman Sketcher's Pocket Box
- Sakura Koi Watercolor set

### Brushes

#8 and #4 Round synthetic or synthetic/natural blend watercolor brushes. Recommended:

- o Black Gold Watercolor Brushes
- Daniel Smith Platinum Series Watercolor Brushes

#### Miscellaneous

- o Soft pencil: 3B or 4B graphite pencil
- o Kneaded eraser
- Roll of paper towels
- Pinch of salt in a plastic baggy or lidded container

Bring this list to the art store, they can be very helpful and often times there may be a 10% discount at some stores if you are a BC student as well.
