Please bring your acrylic painting supplies to the first class. You can use the list below for recommendations or bring the acrylic supplies you like to work with.

Recommended Supply List:

1. **Paint:** Golden (heavy body) and Winsor Newton brand are good acrylic paint choices)
 - Titanium White - 10 fl. oz. jar or tube
 - Mars Black- 5 fl. oz. tube
 - Ultramarine Blue - 5 fl. oz. tube
 - Cerulean Blue- 5 fl. oz. tube
 - Sap Green- 5 fl. oz. tube
 - Hansa Yellow- 5 fl. oz. tube
 - Yellow Ochre - 5 fl. oz. tube
 - Pyrol Red- 5 fl. oz. tube
 - Alizarin Crimsom - 5 fl. oz. tube
 - Burnt Umber- 5 fl. oz. tube
2. **Brushes:** (acrylic brushes like Da Vinci Top Acrylic work well)
 - ½" wide flat
 - ¾" wide flat
 - #14 round
 - #8 round
 - #6 round
 - #2 round
3. **Stretched Canvas:** (Winsor and Newton is a good price) Two 16" x 20" pre-stretched, pre-gessoed (primed) canvases to get started.
4. **Palette:** A disposable paper palette (for acrylics) or a plastic palette.
5. **Palette Knife:** 1 mixing palette knife. Stainless steel is best.
6. **Golden Acrylic Glazing Liquid** (satin) - 1 pint bottle
7. **Spray bottle** for water.
8. **1 roll paper towel**
9. **Water container** – 2 quart or larger (a small bucket works well)

Bring this list to the art store, they can be very helpful and often times there may be a 10% discount at some stores if you are a BC student as well.
