



Underage Policy

Bellevue Community College Continuing Education provides educational offerings primarily for adult learners. Unless a course or program is specifically geared toward a younger age group, students under 18 years may be granted permission to enroll according to the following guidelines.

A. 16 and 17 year old students may enroll in some classes with the required release form. However, certain classes require a minimum age of 18.

B. 12 and 15 year old students may enroll in some classes if accompanied by a parent or adult guardian over 18 registered and participating in the same class.

C. Students under 12 years of age may enroll only in classes specifically designed for that age group.
