You are welcome to collect these supplies for the first class, **but do not need to buy these supplies for the first class. In the first class, we discuss the needed supplies.**

Recommended Watercolor Supply List

Watercolor Paper - One of these pads will do or something equivalent:

- *Fabriano Studio Watercolour Pad*, 140 lb., Cold Press, 15 to 30 sheets. 9" x 12" or larger.
- *Strathmore 400 Series Watercolor Pad*, 140 lb., Cold Press, 15 to 30 sheets. 9" x 12" or larger.

Palette - One of these palettes or something equivalent with plenty of mixing space. A lid is always nice.

- *John Pike Watercolor Palette with the smaller wells* - my favorite.
- *Jones Watercolor Palette*. It has 32 wells for paint and a lid.
- *Richeson Covered Watercolor Palette*. It has 22 wells for paint and a lid.

Paints - Student grade recommended for beginners. Buy the smallest tubes. Good student grade brands are *Winsor and Newton Cotman Watercolor paint* and *Talens Van Gogh Watercolor Paint*

1 small tube(8 ml) of each:

- Alizarin Crimson Hue
- Cadmium Red Deep Hue
- Cadmium Yellow Hue
- Yellow Ochre
- Cerulean Blue Hue
- Ultramarine Blue
- Paynes Grey
- Vandyke Brown
- Sap Green

Brushes - A couple of good choices are: *Princeton Snap Watercolor Brushes* and *Black Gold Watercolor Brushes*.

#10, #8, #4 and two #2 Round synthetic or synthetic/natural blend watercolor brushes.

Miscellaneous -

- Masking Fluid: 1 or 2 oz. bottle. Winsor Newton (yellow tint) recommended.
- Soft pencil: 3B or 4B graphite pencil
- Roll of paper towel
- Brush Holder: bamboo or other

Bring this list to the art store, they can be very helpful and often times there may be a 10% discount at some stores if you are a BC student as well.
