Course Title: Cosplay 101: Costume Planning and Basics

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- Plastic wrap (1 roll)
- Duct tape (1 roll)
- Permanent marker
- Fabric scraps for practicing hand sewing techniques (can be a fabric remnant from a craft store, extra fabric at home, an old clothing item, or bandana—at least 6x6in)
- Thread, needle, buttons (many sewing kits will have all of these)
- Optional: thread ripper and snips, will be included in most sewing kits
- Lace trim, small quantity (craft store, at least 6 in)
- Sculpey clay (small/medium package)
- Tin foil, wax paper, or parchment paper—enough to cover your work surface
- Craft foam: 1-2 sheets of Silly Winks Foam Sheet 5mm/0.5cm thick, 12x18in (Hobby Lobby), other brands are fine but will come in larger sheets/rolls at a higher price
- Scissors/utility knife
- Wood glue, 4 oz bottle or more
- Paint brushes variety pack (4 or more)
- Small plastic cups/palette for paint
- Acrylic paint(s) - colors of choice (will be used to paint an armor piece), 3 oz bottle
- Hot glue gun/glue stick refill pack

Bring this list to the art store, they can be very helpful and often times there may be a 10% discount at some stores if you are a BC student as well.
