No scanned or hard copy proposals will be accepted. No other submission method will be considered. Please answer all questions, save the document and then email your proposal to: ce-programs@bellevuecollege.edu.

If your proposal is accepted, you will be notified and additional information such as instructor availability, supply lists, or special requests will be required prior to course scheduling. New instructors, or instructors who have not been employed by the college within the last year may be required to provide a resume and three references for review, interview with the director, pass a background check and complete new employee paperwork.
