

CAMP INFORMATION

Bellevue College men's and women's soccer programs are excited to host 2011 soccer camps for boys and girls from ages 8-18. The camps with be taught by professional coaches and collegiate players. Camp participants will be able to learn skills sets demonstrated by collegiate players, plus get to play along with them to simulate a collegiate playing environment. Our staff is friendly and eager to work with young athletes to make them into better players.

There will be three-sessions:

Session 1: July 5-8 Session 2: July 25-28 Session 3: August 8-11

Boys and Girls Ages and Times:

Ages 8-13: 9 a.m. - 11 a.m.

Ages 14-18: 11 a.m. - 1:30 p.m.

Sessions are held on the Bellevue College soccer field on the BC campus, just west of the baseball field. Campers are to wear proper soccer attire (shoes, shin guards, shirts, shorts). We will provide water but participants are welcome to bring their own snacks, sports drinks, etc.

The cost per session is \$100 per session or \$150 for two session or \$200 for all three. All registration forms are due five days prior to participation.
