Suggested Items for Housing

Housing provides the following in each suite/apartment common area (shared with roommates/suitemate/apartment mates):

- Refrigerator
- Stove/oven
- Shower curtain and rings
- Common area trash can, recycling bin, and compost container

Housing provides the following to each resident in their bedroom:

- Twin XL bed with a mattress
- Desk with chair
- Two-drawer dresser

Students are required to provide the following for themselves:

- Bedding (Beds are size Twin XL):
 - Sheets (most include pillowcase)
 - Blanket or comforter
 - o Pillow(s)
 - Mattress pad or protector
- Toilet paper
- Toiletries and hygiene supplies of the student's choosing
- Towel(s)
- Food

Students are encouraged to bring any of the following for themselves:

- Kitchen Items
 - o Microwave Safe dishware (bowls, plates, coffee/tea mug, and glasses). Bring enough for yourself
 - o Pot, pan, and small baking sheet
 - Spoons, forks, knives
- Hangers for closet
- Cleaning supplies:
 - o Trash bags
 - Disinfectant spray and/or wipes
 - Glass cleaner
 - o Broom
 - Sponge/dish wand
 - Dish soap
 - Laundry detergent
- Laundry hamper for dirty clothes
- Storage organizers (for bathroom, kitchen, or bedroom)
- Small wastebasket for bedroom
- Phone Charger
- Decorations, such as floor rugs, posters, etc. (No screws, nails, or thumbtacks, please)
- Outlet converters (for students coming from outside of the U.S.)
