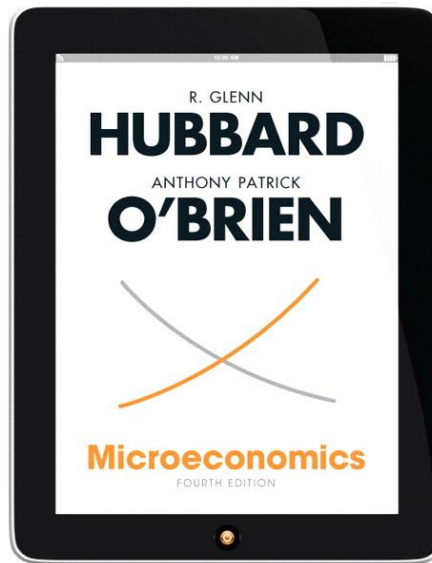

I. OBJECTIVES AND PHILOSOPHY

The course is designed to introduce students to basic principles of microeconomics. We will learn about strengths and weaknesses of market based systems and about different types of market structures. In a nutshell, this course will teach you the important issues to be aware of as a participating agent in a market economy.

II. GRADING
