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Purpose 1.

The purpose of this procedural guideline is for students enrolled in the Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) program to understand what steps to take to register for the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN).

Scope 2.

This standard operating procedure will walk students through the process of getting ready for the NCLEX-RN.

3. Prerequisites

Students must complete and graduate from Bellevue College's Associate Degree in Nursing program.

Responsibilities 4.

It is the responsibility of the student to follow the steps outlined below to register and sit for the NCLEX-RN.

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7. Definitions and Glossary

ADN is the Associate Degree in Nursing program at Bellevue College.

ATT is your Authorization to Test from Pearson VUE.

NCLEX-RN is the National Council Licensure Examination that is completed after graduation from the Nursing program to become a Registered Nurse.

Pearson VUE is the company that delivers high-stakes exams empowering professions to certify and license individuals who safeguard and advance their communities across the globe. Pearson Vue administers the NCLEX examination.

WA State Nursing Commission is the Washington State Nursing Care Quality Assurance Commission (NCQAC), which is Washington State's Nursing Regulatory Body (NRB) that determines your eligibility for your nursing license.

Bellevue College Information and Resources

The Associate Dean of Nursing (Nursing Dean) will send the Certificate of Completion to the Nursing Commission once all names and birthdates of the graduating cohort are received.

In the last quarter of your program, you will take Nursing 260: Transition to Professional Nursing, which will have you take an (Assessment Technology Institute (ATI) RN Comprehensive Predictor assessment. This will tell you what you need to do to increase your NCLEX score along with a live review ATI. Utilize the <u>ATI Assessment</u> <u>Platform</u> to help you prepare for the NCLEX exam and create your own plan.
