Allow 1-3 business days for the Welcome Center to process your application. We send you a Welcome Letter email with instructions for your next steps. The college places a \$55 admission/placement fee on your account at the time we process your application. You pay this fee at the time you pay your first quarter tuition. Once paid, the fee is non-refundable.
