

# Radiation Therapy Program

## Application 2021

*Instructions/Checklist on required documents – you must have the following ready before you go on to Step 4 of the online application process:*

1. **BC Student ID #** - if you just applied or reapplied to BC General Admission processing time is between 5-10 business days. Apply to BC first to get your SID # before proceeding with the program application.
2. **Date of Attendance for Information Session** -- Email [imagingprograms@bellevuecollege.edu](mailto:imagingprograms@bellevuecollege.edu) if you do not remember when you last attended.
3. **RADON Application Prerequisite Form** – Download a [\[PDF copy\]](#) of the form. Form is fillable –just type directly on the form. Once completed save a copy of this worksheet. You will need to upload a completed copy when you fill out your online application. This worksheet should include information on courses that you have taken for the program prerequisites. If you are still in the process of completing prerequisite courses winter quarter 2021, make sure to include those courses in your worksheet. You will not have the grade available yet when you apply so make sure to indicate your expected time of completion for the course/s (winter quarter 2021). It is your responsibility to notify us once you have completed and received a grade so that we can update your application or it will be incomplete. As proof of completion, you will need to submit another unofficial copy of your transcript to Imaging Programs email at: [imagingprograms@bellevuecollege.edu](mailto:imagingprograms@bellevuecollege.edu).
4. **Transcripts** – Unofficial copy of your transcript/s from each college that you have attended for the prerequisite courses. Highlight or underline the courses on your transcript/s to identify them.
5. **Personal Statement** - (required for first time applicants) Prepare a statement of not more than 500 words discussing specific or unique attributes that you will bring to the program; any personal or imposed challenges or hardships you have overcome in pursuing your educational or work goals; or any other special considerations that you believe will make you a good candidate for the program. Please make sure to include your name on top of the page.
6. **Re-applicant Statement** - (required for re-applicants) if you applied to the program the previous year and did not get in, you will need to submit a re-applicant statement. The Re-applicant statement is a time for you to highlight the things that you have done over the past year to strengthen this year's application. Please make sure to include your name on top of the page.
7. **Hospital Observation Form** – Upload a completed/signed copy of your hospital observation form if you have completed this requirement. Deadline for completing this requirement is March 31, 2021. It is required for applicants to attend an information session first for this requirement. If you haven't completed your Hospital Observation by time you apply, make sure to send a copy of it to [imagingprograms@bellevuecollege.edu](mailto:imagingprograms@bellevuecollege.edu) once completed so we can include it with your application. Complete this requirement by March 31, 2021.

Hospital Observations – complete by March 31, 2021  
Interview letters sent out – First week of April 2021  
Interviews – To be determined (usually 2nd Wednesday in April)  
Acceptance Letters sent out – June 2021
