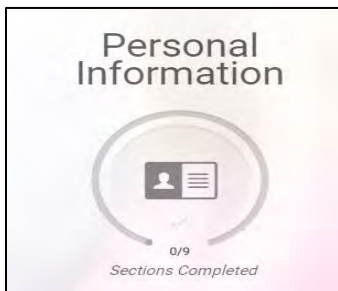


# Common App & Radiation Therapy Program Application Checklist

- Search for Bellevue College & select the + to the left of the Radiation Therapy Program

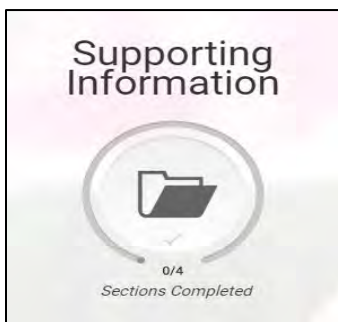
## My Application



- Complete all required fields & as many of the non-required fields as you would like under the Personal Information Section. Biographic, citizenship, race & ethnicity information is not used in the admissions process.



- Complete all required fields in the following sections: High Schools Attended and Colleges Attended. You will know it is required if it has a red asterisk (\*) on it.
- Sections that are optional and can be opted out :
  - College Coursework
  - GPA Entries
  - Standardized Tests
  - Continuing Education Courses
  - SAT Subject
  - IB (International Baccalaureate)
  - CLEP (College Level Examination Program)
  - Senior Secondary Leaving Examinations
