Needed Materials Checklist

This list provides an example of the materials required of all college students. It's a tool to prepare for the upcoming term. If you are missing any materials, make a plan to obtain them!



Required textbooks for each class - be sure to have a plan for textbooks. You MUST have regular access to textbooks for each class. If you cannot afford to buy them, consider renting, or, check the library to see if the book is on reserve. Not all textbooks are on reserve at the library, so check online the first week of the quarter!
Class syllabus for each class – keep a copy of your syllabi where you can easily access it.
Calendar with monthly, weekly and daily sections – hard copy or online
Pens and pencils
Notebooks or paper
Organizational system (binders, notebooks with pockets, accordion files, etc. – whatever works best for you)
Other class-required materials
Flash drive - it's extremely important to back up your homework each time you do it. Instructors expect you to have a Plan B for computer problems.
Laptop or tablet if you use one at school
Wi-fi connection, monitor, camera, mic if you will attend online classes
A transportation plan if you will attend on campus classes
Anything else you think you'll need
