





CEO classes are limited to 20 students per class



How does LIP lead to college classes?

CEO/LIP is a full-time, 15 credit hour, pre-college level English language and academic skills program specifically designed for young adults.

- 1. Start LIP based on intake assessment placement**
- 2. Advance levels based on successful completion of courses. Repeat levels if needed to master skills**
- 3. Pass LIP level 6 & place into English 092/093 or English 101**

(# of quarters depends on initial English level + student engagement, average time ~3-9 quarters)




