



**Associate in Music Degree (DTA/MRP)

The Associate in Music Direct Transfer Agreement degree consists of a minimum of **104 credits** as outlined. This pathway is applicable to students planning to prepare for upper division bachelor's degree majors in music and is designed for students wishing to transfer to The University of Washington, Washington State University, Central Washington University, Western Washington University, Eastern Washington University, The Evergreen State College, Pacific Lutheran University, Northwest University, Saint Martin's University, Seattle University, and Whitworth University.
