Qualifications

- Under 35 years of age at time of enlistment
- Must be a US citizen or permanent resident (green card holder)
- Must meet height/weight standards at time of enlistment
- Certain medical conditions may disqualify an applicant
- Certain legal history (especially felonies) may disqualify an applicant
