Education Support for Veterans and Their Families

No VA Benefits? No Problem. If you or your family members have served but aren't eligible for VA education benefits, you still have powerful options. The **Military Community Assistance Program** at Bellevue College will help you return to school—**with tuition coverage, funds for school supplies, and assistance for personal expenses**—so you can focus on your future, and not your finances.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Veteran – Served at least one day in the military (any discharge status)
- Family Member – Spouse or children of veterans. (verification of relationship required)
- King County Resident
- Household income cannot exceed 60% of the Area Median Income.
- Not eligible for VA education benefits (GI Bill®, Dependents Education Assistance)
